

Draft - CLEAN CITIES GRANTS  
STATE ENERGY PROGRAM (SEP)  
NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY  
January 26, 2005

The U.S. Department of Energy announced State Energy Program Special Projects funding availability for Federal Fiscal year 2005. Approximately \$4,000,000 nationwide is available for award to Clean Cities eligible applicants. All proposals are required to be submitted by a Florida Clean Cities Coalition stakeholder and our Florida Energy Office. There are 6 categories of activity for proposals due in March to enable fleet customers to increase use of AFVs to reduce emissions and energy consumption. Funded projects must display Clean Cities decal.

Category 01A - Clean Cities AFV Incremental Cost to promote acquisition of commercially-available AFVs that maximize alternative fuel use, especially medium- and heavy-duty highway vehicles for incremental cost of fueling system. \$800,000 for up to 4-8 projects .

Category 01B - Clean Cities Refueling Infrastructure projects are to promoting infrastructure development including new dispensing facilities or equipment upgrades and improvements to existing AFV refueling sites. \$1,600,000 for up to 11-15 projects for 150,000 per project with 30 % cost share.

Category 01C - Clean Cities School Buses projects are to promoting (through funding portion of incremental cost) the acquisition of commercially available alternative fuel school busses and bus platforms and new and upgrade of existing refueling infrastructure. \$400,000 for up to 4 projects with % cost share.

Category 01E - Clean Cities Idle Reduction Technologies projects are to promote reduction and/or eliminate engine idling of heavy duty vehicles by funding demonstration and evaluation projects for sustainable technologies for energy efficiency. \$400,000 for up to 2 projects with percent cost share

Category 01F - Clean Cities Hybrid Electric Vehicle projects are to promoting full funding of incremental cost of hybrid electric system in heavy-duty vehicles over conventional vehicle. \$200,000 for 2 projects.
